

<u> 2025 FLAT TRACK AT THE FAIR CLASS LIST</u>

- Stock Youth Quad: Up to 12 years old, 0-90cc two stroke, 0-125cc four stroke, NO DRR or Apex (any style tires), will be split by age
- Modified Youth Quad: Up to 12 years old, 0-100cc two stroke, 0-150cc four stroke (any style tires)
- Youth Motorcycle: *Up to 13 years old,* 0-85cc two stroke, 0-125cc four stroke, will be split by cc
- School Age: 12-16 years old, 0-265cc two stroke, 0-400cc four stroke (any style tires)
- Quad C: Recommended for inexperienced racers, 14 years old and up, any size two or four stroke (knobby tires only) NO pro riders.
- Quad B: 14 years old and up, any size two or four stroke (split by tire type) NO pro riders.
- Quad A: 15 years old and up, any size two or four stroke (any style tires)
- Pro Quad: 16 years old and up, any size two or four stroke (any style tires)
- 4x4 Quad: 14 years old and up, any size two or four stroke (any style tires)
- 30+ Open Quad: 30 years old and up, any size two or four stroke (any style tires) NO proriders.
- Women's Quad: 14 years old and up, any size two or four stroke (any style tires)
- Side-by-Side/UTV: 16 years old and up, any state approved UTV, no passengers
- Open A Motorcycle: 16 years old and up, any size two or four stroke (flat track tires only)
- Open B Motorcycle: 13 years old and up, any size two or four stroke (any style tire)
- **Boonie:** 14 years old and up, must be auto-clutch, single speed or CVT. Must originate with & retain pull start from manufacturer. Must have functional kill switch mounted on handlebar. Max wheel size: 12 inches
- Adult PeeWee: 18 years old and up, 0-125cc bike or quad

- *The board has the right to pull any rider out of the class if they feel he or she is not capable of handling their machine and/or the class they signed up for.
- •SAFETY is #1! All riders are REQUIRED to have a HELMET, GLOVES, EYE PROTECTION, LONG PANTS and BOOTS that come higher than the ankle.
- Quads must have nerf bars and a
 FUNCTIONAL TETHER KILL SWITCH will be tech inspection!
- Number plates must be displayed on the FRONT, REAR and LEFT side to be scored.
